### **Declaration 001 – Support Discovery in Election Integrity Lawsuit**

On October 14, 2022 an election integrity lawsuit was filed in the United States District Court for the District of Oregon, (Case No. 3:22-CV-01516-SB). This lawsuit “challenges the constitutionality of mail-in voting and computerized tabulation of elections in Oregon because of widespread evidence of fraud, suppression of the vote, and disenfranchisement.” The lawsuit is filed against the Secretary of State, Shemia Fagan, and multiple counties.

Outlined in the lawsuit are examples of obstruction or refusal by county officials to produce election records. The lawsuit requests that the presiding judge:

1. Enter an Order finding and declaring it unconstitutional for any public election to be conducted using any model of electronic voting system to cast or tabulate votes and enjoining the use of such systems.
2. Enter an Order finding and declaring that Oregon’s vote-by-mail system is unconstitutional and enjoin the use of vote-by-mail in Oregon.
3. Retain jurisdiction to ensure Defendants’ ongoing compliance with the foregoing Orders.
4. Grant Plaintiffs an award of their reasonable attorneys’ fees, costs, and expenses incurred in this action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 1988.
5. Grant Plaintiffs such further and other relief as the Court deems just

The Douglas County Commissioners must enter an Answer or a Motion to Dismiss by December 16, 2022. By entering an Answer, the case will move forward, and discovery will continue.

#### **Now therefore, it is hereby declared that:**

The Douglas County Republican Central Committee’s Executive Board supports the full investigation of our elections to ensure the highest integrity is maintained. An Answer to this lawsuit will allow investigation and discovery to continue. The Executive Board supports the Douglas County Commissioners in submitting an Answer the Complaint filed by December 16, allowing the case to move forward.
