Resolution 004: Resolution Opposing the World Health Organization's Legal Acquisition of U.S. Public Health Emergency Authority

The World Health Organization (WHO) is preparing amendments to the International Health Regulations (IHR), a legally binding international agreement. If adopted, the amendments could surrender future U.S. public health emergency authority to the WHO.

WHEREAS the amendments would change the IHR from legally “non-binding” to binding;

WHEREAS the change would introduce and initiate digital “health certificates,” including vaccine passports;

WHEREAS the change would allow the WHO to enforce lockdown measures at the discretion of WHO Director-General;

WHEREAS the change would allow WHO to declare an emergency at will;

WHEREAS the change would allow the removal of critical language that grants “full respect for the dignity, human rights and fundamental freedoms of persons”;

WHEREAS the change would commandeer medical supplies and require nations to use only certain medications;

WHEREAS the citizens of the United States of America and the citizens of the State of Oregon require protection from a mass power grab by unelected WHO officials;

WHEREAS this action will usurp the power of our federal and state elected officials to govern (H.R. 79);

WHEREAS the amendments would surrender future U.S. public health emergency authority to the WHO;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Douglas County Republican Party condemns this move by WHO to acquire U.S. public health emergency authority. We call on all elected Republican officials in Oregon and the United States to voice their opposition to the non-elected and legally binding transfer of power and authority. Furthermore, we resolve that any Republican elected official, who fails to stand against this attempt to usurp the sovereign rights of the citizens and people of the United States of America, will have violated the Oregon Republican Platform and will no longer have the support of the Oregon Republican Party
